Wednesday Children's Programs

At CCC we believe that children should be given the opportunity to hear the Word of God taught to them on their level and with their interests in mind. We have great staff who work diligently each week to prepare activities, games and structured times of worship and prayer so that our kids can grow in God at their own pace and in their own space.

For the comfort and safety of all our children, we have provided two programs that run on Wednesday nights for our children. Our nursery is located on the top level across from the church office, and welcomes children from birth to age three. In this safe environment, our children are surrounded by caring adults who facilitate their interaction with our church community and other children.

Our school-age children (ages 4-11) participate in Kids Power Hour in the lower auditorium. Here they participate in games, activities and discussions about God's Word and their relationship with God and His church. In this high-energy, entertaining and fun environment, our kids learn essential concepts, skills and biblical truths that will last a lifetime.

These age divisions have been created so that we may provide your child with the best possible experience at CCC. We ask that you kindly help us in maintaining these divisions. Our Wednesday night staff has experienced minor issues and even small injuries when young children attend the program designed for our school-aged kids.

If your child is missing out on these great programs, we encourage your family to come by and find out first-hand what is happening with our kids on Wednesday night at CCC!
